  - You mowed 2 lawns (2, \_\_\_)
  - You mowed 3 lawns (3, \_\_\_)
  - You earned \$100 dollars (\_\_\_, 100)
  - You earned \$200 dollars (\_\_\_, 200)
- Look at the point that I plotted.  
Did I plot it correctly?  
How do you know?
