Purpose and Goals	The goal of Montgomery County schools is to improve the reading performance of identified exceptional students receiving the standard course of study curriculum and performing at levels I, II and III on the Reading EOG performance test across the system.
Description	Exceptional and regular education students in grades 6-8 scoring at level I, II and III on the EOG in reading receive interventions in decoding and comprehension for forty-five minutes daily using Corrective Reading.

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Description of Model

Corrective Reading is designed to promote reading accuracy (decoding), fluency, and comprehension skills of students in third grade or higher who are reading below their grade level. The program has four levels that address students' decoding skills and six levels that address students' comprehension skills. All lessons in the program are sequenced and scripted.
