**Purpose and Goals**

Yadkin County Schools is located in a rural setting in northwest North Carolina. The purpose of the school system is to provide their students with the best quality education they possibly can. A goal of the Yadkin County Schools is to produce productive, ethical, hard working students who strive for success.

**Description Of Students**

Yadkin County Schools serves children from Preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The system has approximately 6,200 students, with 1,090 of them being placed in the Exceptional Children Program.

**Description of Instructional Model**

The research-based instruction models that will be used are Wilson Foundations, the Wilson Reading System, and SRA Corrective Reading.

**Instructional Methods**

Teachers in Yadkin County will teach language arts through the balanced literacy approach. K-2 teachers will supplement the core language arts program with Wilson Foundations which provides a systematic phonics approach via 25-30 minute lessons per day. Exceptional children teachers will use the systematic multisensory Wilson Reading System and the direct instruction program SRA Corrective Reading with those students who would benefit from daily pullout intensive instruction for 40 minutes. Selected trained staff members will assess all K-2 students in the project schools
