#### Purpose and Goals

The purpose of Duplin County's participation in NCSIP is to establish and implement personnel development and support services to improve the performance and success of students with disabilities enrolled in Duplin County Schools.

The four major goals to accomplish this purpose are to:

1. Improve the basic skills performance of students with disabilities.
2. Increase the percentage of qualified teachers of students with disabilities.
3. Increase graduation rates and decrease dropout rates of students with disabilities.
4. Improve parent satisfaction and increase parental participation in the education of their children.

#### Description Of Students

Twelve schools are involved with NCSIP. These include 4 K-5 schools, 1 K-6 school, 3 K-8 schools, 3 6-8 schools, and 1 7-12 school. Students with all recognized exceptionalities are included. Settings include separate, resource and regular. There are twenty-two Foundations trained teachers serving 220 students in reading instruction.

#### Description of Instructional Model

Each school has adopted one or more direct instruction reading programs including Language! 3<sup>rd</sup>. edition, Read Well, Language for Learning, Reading Mastery Plus, and Corrective Reading.
